 - Bring your pH and EC meters along with pH 4 and 7 buffers, if you have them.
 - Bring your most recent water analysis results
 - Bring your fertilizer program written on a piece of paper
 - Bring the information on your injectors, what type and dilution ratios

- What you can expect to learn:**
- Interpreting water quality and making decisions for your crops, bedding plants, ornamentals, vegetables and cannabis
 - Water and climate control strategies
 - Understanding pH and EC and management over the duration of crops
 - Preparing a good fertilizer program

We have asked Dr. Mirza to actually take you through a fertilizer calculation in ppm so that you have no fear. Jackie Bantle, Manager, Ag. Greenhouses & Horticulture Field Facility will be on hand to help us out.
